RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Total of twenty sheep will be used.
- Dogs must be kept quiet and away from trial area while other dogs are competing.
- The next competitor must be available with their dog ten minutes before they are due to compete.
- Dogs may be disqualified at the judges discretion.
- Dogs wearing muzzles will be penalised four points.
- The competitor may retire at any time.
- Dogs taking excess time will be rung off.
- Scores from the elimination rounds will be displayed.
- When finals are conducted, the winning score will be the aggregate score of the two rounds.
- The judges decision will be final.
- Competitors are to leave gates as found.
- Competitors may assist the dog in keeping the sheep flowing, but assistance may be penalised.
- Bitches on heat are not permitted on the grounds.
- Score sheets will be available after completion of the finals.
- The organising committee, in conjunction with the SAYDA committee, reserves the right to charge the rulings and regulations as required on the day.
- It is the competitor's responsibility if their dog bites or injures a member of the public in any way.
- No dog may be substituted for a dog already nominated, less than twenty-four hours before the commencement of a trial.
- Declarations must be signed.

CONDITIONS

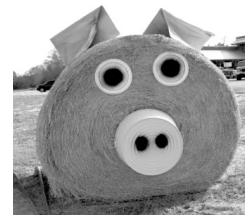
All competing dogs must have been vaccinated against canine distemper, canine infectious hepatitis and canine parvo virus within the previous 12 months but no later than two weeks prior to competition.

A CERTIFICATE MUST BE PRESENTED IF REQUESTED

The breed, shape, sex and colour of the dogs are not taken into consideration. Dogs biting or pulling wool excessively will be penalised. Muzzles may be worn.
